- Secretary's report (Leslie Freymann): previous minutes accepted.
- Treasurer's report (Sheila Rotter): balance = \$ 2715.72
- [PDK Watch](#) Report (Ron Dennis): the Board of Commissioners will discuss PDK at their next meeting.
- Networking of Northeast Neighborhood (NNN) Report (Ron Dennis): future meetings will discuss the Redevelopment Powers Act and Tax Allocation Districts.
- Dresden Park Report (Cheryl Von Soosten): County is reviewing the master plan and St. Pious X's involvement; master plan includes renovation is for 2 ball fields, moving the parking lot, walking paths, play area, restrooms, clean-up of all underbrush (except for 75 foot creek buffer); funding is not available; the County has to prioritize; St. Pious X aggress to maintain fields; next Steering Committee meeting is Dec. 5th; after finalizing the plan, they will present to the CEO, County Commissioners, and the public; Mr. VonSoosten is the Committee Representative.
- Yard of the Month Report (Leslie Freymann): all the winners are online. Sheila Rotter has free mulch she is trying to give away.
- Community Council/Zoning (Dan Harris): issued citations on Duke road, across from PDK.
- DCCC Report (Wayne Daniel): the new subdivision ordinance passed.
